

Rules and Guidelines for Krishna Kids Contest 2020

Rules

1. Parents need to register and donate towards the contest before 10th August, 2020.
2. Post registration only they should submit entries towards any one or all of the contests.
3. Please note entries received after 10th August 2020 will not be considered for evaluation.
4. Child can participate in any one or all of the contests for a donation of Rs 200 except Toddlers.
5. First entry against each Registration ID will be considered and treated as final.
6. Please ensure you are signed into your **Gmail account** while submitting your entry.
7. For each child there will be a unique Registration ID which needs to be entered while submitting the entry.
8. List of eligible events for each group.
 - a. **Toddlers** (6 months to 2 years)
 - i. Pauranik Costume only
 - b. **Sub Juniors** (3 to 5 years) & **Juniors** (6 to 8 Years)
 - i. Drawing and Colouring
 - ii. Public Speaking
 - iii. Bhajans and Kirtans
 - iv. Gita Shloka Recitation
 - v. Contemporary Dance
 - vi. Traditional Dance
 - vii. Pauranik Costume
 - c. **Seniors** (9 to 11 years) & **Teens** (12 to 15 years)
 - i. Drawing and Colouring
 - ii. Public Speaking
 - iii. Bhajans and Kirtans
 - iv. Creative Writing
 - v. Gita Shloka Recitation
 - vi. Contemporary Dance
 - vii. Traditional Dance
 - viii. Pauranik Costume
9. YouTube Links of the performance needs to be submitted for our evaluation.
10. For all the videos- the participating child
 - a. Needs to introduce Self
 - b. Any one parent name
 - c. Parent mobile number
 - d. Batch &
 - e. The contest the child is participating in.
11. Video has to be in Single Take. Edited videos may be disqualified.
12. For the images/pdf submitted- Name of the child. Batch, registration ID and parents mobile number needs to be clearly visible.
13. Submissions received are our copy right and may be used in future for promotion of our Cultural Education Initiatives like Culture Camp. ICVK Classes. Winter Camp. Vedic Contests etc.
14. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
15. Organisers reserve rights to disqualify an entry.
16. Request parents and children to participate fairly as each of your work is an offering to Lord Krishna by you.
17. Special E-Certificate will be awarded to winners and their names will be published in our Website and Social media Handles.
18. The organizing committee can change the rules without any prior notification.

Guidelines

✓ Drawing and Colouring Competition

Eligibility- 3 Years – 15 Years.

Children in the age group 6 to 8 years can draw and paint by choosing any one topic from the following

1. Krishna with his butter pot
2. Krishna with his calf

Children in the age group 9-15 years can draw and paint by choosing any one topic from the following

1. Gopas and Krishna breaking the butter pot
2. Govardhan Leela
3. Lord Krishna and Radharani at the Vrindavan garden.

Any type of Colour can be used (Crayons, Sketch-pens, Poster colours etc.)

The Topic, Name of the child, Name of the parent, Parent's WhatsApp number & the age category to be mentioned clearly on the drawing sheet.

Image of their Painting or colouring has to be shared as a pdf/jpeg /any image file while submitting the entry.

Judgement Criteria: Visual appeal, Colour combination, Creativity and Neatness.

✓ Public Speaking Competition

Eligibility- 3 Years – 15 Years.

Participants to speak in **English** on any one of the topics mentioned below as per age category for maximum 3 minutes

1. For 3-6 years & 6-9 years
 - I. Sri Krishna is my superhero
 - II. Sri Krishna's Govardhan Lila
 - III. Sri Krishna's love for butter
2. For 9- 15 years
 - I. Bhagavad Gita teaches me to
 - II. My Favourite verse from Bhagavad Gita and why
 - III. Lessons I learnt from the Life of Sri Krishna

Video of the Child needs to be uploaded in YouTube with the following: -

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch, parent name and mobile number
- Child Speaking on the topic for maximum 3 minutes.
- Submission to be recorded in a single take.

Judgement Criteria – Content, Creativity, Fluency, Voice Modulation, Pronunciation, Clarity of speech, Body Language and Vocabulary

✓ **Creative Writing Competition (CWC)**

Eligibility- 9 Years – 15 Years.

Submission should not exceed **500** words and should be in **English** on the **given themes only**.
Choose any one of the following:

1. A Day with Sri Krishna during lockdown.
2. Relevance of Bhagavad Gita in current age
3. If Lord Krishna was to give you three boons what would you ask and why?.

Essay to be properly structured with an introduction, body and conclusion.

Please send/upload neatly typed entries.

Only one entry per student is allowed.

Judges' decision will be final .

Name your attachment by prefixing the respective. Child Name, Batch. Reg ID

Judgement criteria: Creativity, Legibility, Language proficiency, Style, Grammatical correctness and Vocabulary

✓ **Bhagavad Gita Shloka Recitation Competition**

Eligibility- 3 Years – 15 Years.

Participants should close the eyes and recite Bhagavad-gita Shlokas.

1. Age Group: - 3- 5 Years - Any 2 Bhagavad Gita Shlokas
2. Age Group: - 6- 8 Years - Any 3 Bhagavad Gita Shlokas
3. Age Group: - 9-11 Years, - Any 2 Bhagavad Gita Shlokas with Meanings.
4. Age Group: - 12 – 15 years- Any 3 Bhagavad Gita Shlokas with Meanings.

Video of the Child with Bhagavad Gita Shloka needs to be uploaded in YouTube with the following:-

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch, parent name and mobile number
- Child to mention the shloka Number Example Chapter 12 Verse 4

Child can present for maximum 3 minutes.

Judgement Criteria- Clarity in Pronunciation, Presentation, Confidence and Voice Modulation

✓ **Bhajans and Kirtans Competition**

Eligibility: 3 Years – 15 Years

Participants can sing any Vaishnava / Krishna Bhajan or Kirtans.

It should be a Solo performance.

Video of the Child with Bhajan/ Kirtan needs to be uploaded with the following :-

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch , parent name and mobile number and mention the Bhajan/Kirtan (eg. Yashomati Nandana)

Child can sing Bhajan/ Kirtan for maximum 3 minutes.

Judgement Criteria :- Voice Quality, Raga, Bhava, Rhythm Synchronization and Co-ordination.

✓ **Pauranik Costume Contest**

Eligibility: 6 Months – 15 Years.

Participants may dress up as Krishna/ Radha/ any Character from Ramayana/ Mahabharata/Puranas. Materials/accessories available at home can be used.

Video of the Child needs to be uploaded in YouTube with the following: -

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch, parent name and mobile number
- Child can speak for maximum 3 minutes.
- Submission to be recorded in a single take.
- For 6 Months to 4 Years- parents can introduce and take the video of the child.

Judgement Criteria :- Make up and Costume, Authenticity, and Overall Presentation.

✓ **Dance Contest- Traditional**

Eligibility- 3 Years – 15 Years.

Participants will present Traditional Dance (Kathak, Bharatanatyam, Odissi Etc.) on Krishna/ Vaishnava Songs.

Video of the Child needs to be uploaded in YouTube with the following: -

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch, parent name and mobile number also additionally can set up the context for the performance.
- Child can dance for maximum 4 minutes.
- Submission to be recorded in a single take.

Dress code- Traditional Attire.

Please avoid

- Shorts or short skirts.
- Tank tops or Tube tops.

Judgement Criteria :- Rhythm, Synchronisation with the song, Expression, Confidence , Make up , Costume, Authenticity and Visual Presentation.

✓ **Dance Contest- Contemporary**

Eligibility- 3 Years – 15 Years.

Participants will present Contemporary Dance on Krishna/ Vaishnava Songs.

Video of the Child needs to be uploaded in YouTube with the following: -

- Participating child to introduce with name, batch, parent name and mobile number also additionally can set up the context for the performance.
- Child can dance for maximum 4 minutes.
- Submission to be recorded in a single take.

Please avoid

- Shorts or short skirts.
- Tank tops or Tube tops.

Judgement Criteria :- Rhythm, Synchronisation with the song, Expression, Confidence , Make up , Costume, Authenticity and Visual Presentation.
